Recent Action of the Church Board

- The church board reviewed staff positions and compensations and made adjustments to salaries to compensate for budget short falls. Pastor Blank and Gary Hofmann have volunteered to take a pay cut. Doug Thornhill will cut hours back from three days to two days per week.
- Over \$3,000 came in from the 5K race last week. After expenses are deducted, the remainder will be given to the Help Center.
- A heat unit was repaired at the cost of \$3,100.
- Discussion took place about security and ways to improve. All outside locks will be changed and key pads will be installed in an effort to secure the building and identify who has accessed the building. Officer Clark has given some valuable information regarding ways to improve our security.
- There was discussion about the importance of each board member living a life that is above reproach and the need to lead by example.
- Prayer time was very special as we lifted up the needs of the church and its people to God.
